



Tennessee proposes to revise reporting due dates - SB 1859

On January 24, 2018, Tennessee SB 1859 was introduced to amend Section 66-29-125. If passed, the report due date will move Tennessee from a spring reporting state to a fall reporting state. The transition will be as follows:

For property held:	Report before:
January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017	May 1, 2018
January 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019	November 1, 2019
July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020 and thereafter	November 1 of 2020 and each year thereafter

The act is to take effect upon becoming a law.

What does this mean to you?

If enacted, holders will need to make necessary system updates to accommodate the new reporting periods. If reporting is processed through a third party vendor, ensure vendor systems are also updated accordingly.
